

Jacksonport Maifest

2022 Art Fair Celebrating its 49th year!

Date: Memorial Day Weekend, Saturday & Sunday, May 28-29, 2022

Time: 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM Saturday, 9:00 - 4:00 PM Sunday

Setup Time: Saturday 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM (see map for check in location)

Place: Lakeside Park & Erskine Rest Area, Jacksonport, WI at the intersection of HWY 57 & County V Maifest is sponsored by the Jacksonport Area Business Association, it includes well-advertised activities: A Parade Saturday morning, children's activities, live music both days, horse pull, as well as 2K Fun Run and 10K Run. A variety of food and beverages, and of course the Art Fair.

Maifest Policies:

- All work that is displayed for sale **MUST** be made by the exhibitor. **NO WHOLESALE. NO BUY/SELL.**
- No work made with the use of commercial kits, molds, or patterns.
- Booth space is 12 x 12. Each artist must have his/her own space and if needed, may rent two spaces. Booth assignments will be posted on picnic tables on each side of HWY 57 on Friday, May 27th by noon.
- There is no electrical service in the park.
- There is no parking in, or adjacent to either display area. All exhibitors must park behind the baseball field or across from the baseball field (the baseball field is located on Co V about ½ block West of HWY 57). The layout of both parks makes loading and unloading very congested.
- No refunds in case of inclement weather.
- Please use the **LARGE DUMPSTER** for boxes, packing material, etc. located at the NE corner of Lakeside Park. (see the attached map)
- Application deadline is April 1, 2022
- Notification will be by April 19, 2022. After notification the application fee is non-refundable to accepted vendors.
- Directors of Maifest reserve the right to have removed, at showtime, any work they feel is distasteful, not representative of the quality of work described/photographed in the application plus any BUY/SELL items.
- Official setup is from 7 - 9AM Saturday. Vendors can setup on Friday afternoon, however there is **NO SECURITY** on Friday overnight.
- Security is provided Saturday overnight.
- Per Fire Department regulations, no smoking is allowed in or behind the tents

Every application must include all the items below:

- Completed application form.
- \$115 check payable to **Jacksonport Area Business Association** for each space requested.
- Completed "Wisconsin Temporary Event Operator and Seller Information" form.
- Two photos of your work and a third photo of your booth as it appears when set up.
- A self-addressed, stamped envelope for acceptance/rejection notification unless you select email notification on your application.
